



"Handle With Care" adapts the messages of Fight BAC™ to address the care of infants and young children, specifically. It also addresses choking prevention, another important food safety issue for children.

Infants and children are particularly susceptible to foodborne illness because their immune systems are not yet fully developed to fight infection. Yet, most food safety instructional materials do not specifically target this group or their parents.

Handle With Care lessons, fact sheets, and posters are perfect to use with small groups or in one-on-one counseling sessions. All components stress the importance of cleanliness and thorough cooking to prevent foodborne illness. The program is used throughout New Jersey with WIC, EF-NEP, FS-NEP, parents, grandparents raising grandchildren groups, hospitals, and daycare centers.
