How Does *America Saves* Work?

1. Participants enroll by returning the form on this page to the CFA's *America Saves* address in Washington, D.C.
2. Participants receive a quarterly *America Saver* newsletter from the CFA and local support services from Rutgers Cooperative Extension.
3. Periodic progress reports are requested to track your increased savings and/or reduced debt, and to provide motivation to save.
